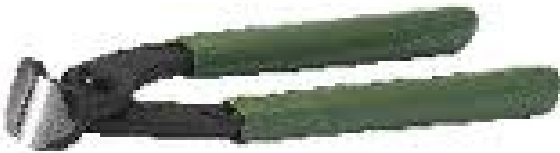

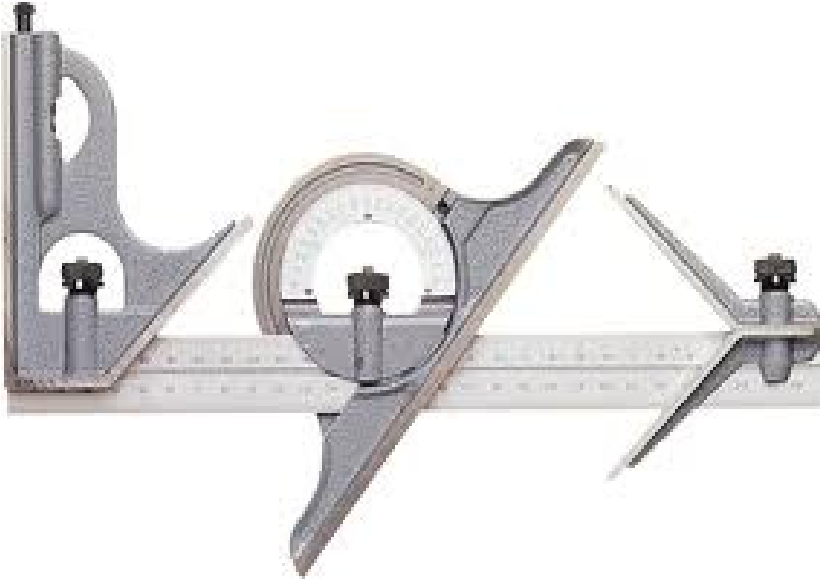

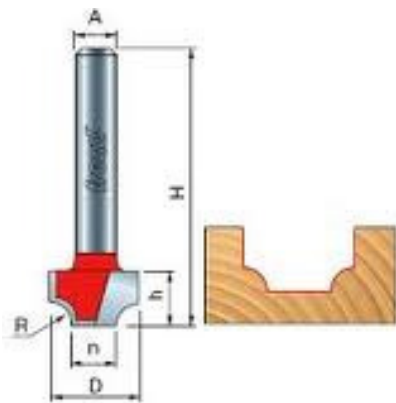

#15 Hard to sand



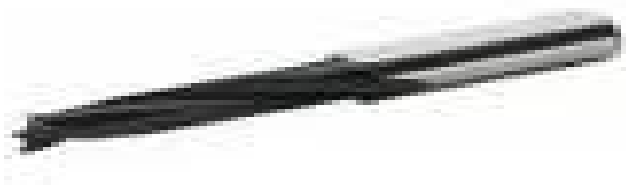
#16 Set of wood drill
